*The Educational Institution Alberto Einstein is pleased to extend a cordial invitation to the United Nations Model CAENU XIII organized by our Institution. Our objective is to promote a space for debate in which students from different schools from inside and outside the country can act in representation of international ambassadors to propose solutions to global problems. Diplomacy, cooperation, negotiation and commitment skills are also developed. The Model will be held on the days **30 Thursday of November, 1 Friday of December, 2 Saturday of December and 3 Sunday of December** of this year within our installations. The central phrase of the model is "**Creating opportunities for cooperation in the present, to guarantee a stable future**"*

This event will be attended by students who are studying from the Ninth grade of General Basic Education to the Third General Unified High School, who must form delegations of four to six delegates representing the country that is assigned. In the same way, delegates attending the International Court of Justice may do so individually or in pairs. The Model will have eight different committees: Comité Ético-Ambiental, Comité Económico-Social, Comité Político-Jurídico, Organización de Estados Americanos (OEA), Consejo de Seguridad, Historical Security Council, Human Rights Council, International Court of Justice et Le Haut Commissariats Nations Unies pour les Réfugiés (HUR).

*Each committee will discuss the topics included in **Annex 1**, so students should prepare accordingly. It should be emphasized that there will be an open agenda in the Consejo de Seguridad, the Historical Security Council, the Human Rights Council and Le Haut Commissariat Nations Unies pour les Réfugiés, so that problems can arise that are pertinent to the objectives of these committees, which are outside of the specified topics.*

*We also want to extend an invitation to students interested in being chair in any of the committees to submit their respective application. They will act as moderators of the committee and lead the debate. With this intention we attach **Annex 2** with detailed information on the application.*

*In order for students to express their creativity and knowledge, the essay contest of the United Nations Model CAENU XIII will be held, which will be optional. Attached is detailed information on the contest in **Annex 3**.*

The registration fee for the model is US \$ 50.00 per school and US \$ 40.00 per delegate, which will be used in snacks, lunches, certificates and materials for the four-day model development. The registration fee must be canceled by each institution.

*We request your confirmation of participation to the event until **Friday, October 27** of this year.*

We hope to have your presence for what, we are sure, will be an enriching experience. We thank in advance the attention to the present.
